ORDINANCE NO. 280

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND GRADE ORDINANCE NO. 278.

An Ordinance to amend an Ordinance fixing and establishing the grade on College Street, from the intersection on College Street, with West Point Street at the West end of said College Street at 2400 lin.feet East to the Central of Georgia Ry. Co. Right-of-Way, and the West side thereof where the same crosses College Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, that Grade Ordinance No. 278 of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, adopted and approved on July 30th, 1937, as follows: "That the Grade of College Street and that the curb on both sides thereof is from the intersection of said College Street at the West end thereof with West Point Street at 2400 feet East to the West side of the Central of Georgia Company Right-of-Way where the same crosses College Street," be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: "That the Grade of College Street, and that the curbs on both sides thereof from the intersection of said College at the West end thereof with West Point Street at 2400 lin. feet East to the West side of the Central of Georgia Ry. Co. Right of Way where the same crosses College Street, and the same is hereby fixed as shown on Profile Sheets X-1 and X-2 heretofore exhibited to the City Council and now on file in the City Council Chamber, and that all other Ordinances in confluct herewith be repealed to the extent of such conflict."
