
GRADE ORDINANCE NO. 291

An Ordinance fixing and establishing the Grade on Louina Street from where the East end of Louina Street intersects the paving at the Westerly end of Main Street 1600 Lin. feet West to the Eastern end of the wooden over-head bridge across the A. B. & C. Railroad tracks.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, That the Grade of Louina Street and that the curb on both sides thereof is from where the East end of Louina Street intersects the paving at the Westerly end of Main Street 1600 Lin. feet West to the Eastern end of the wooden overhead bridge across the A. B. & C. Railroad tracks and the same is hereby fixed as shown on Profile Sheets L-1 and L-2 heretofore exhibited to the City Council and now on file in the City Council Chamber, and that all other Ordinances in conflict herewith be replaced to the extent of such conflict.


