

GRADE ORDINANCE NO. 304

An Ordinance fixing and establishing the Grade on Kirk Street from the end of the pavement on the east end of Kirk Street down Kirk Street westwardly 584 feet to where Kirk Street joins the east side of paving on Chestnut Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, as follows:

That the Grade of Kirk Street, and that the curbs on both sides thereof from the end of the pavement on the east end of Kirk Street down Kirk Street westwardly 584 feet to where Kirk Street joins the east side of Paving on Chestnut Street, and the same is hereby fixed as shown on Profile Sheet AZ-1, and heretofore exhibited to the City Council and now on file in the City Council Chamber.
