

GRADE ORDINANCE NO.212


An Ordinance fixing and establishing the grade of East Main or Rock Mills Road, from the end of the present brick paving to a point 2100 feet east to Anglin Street; and Opelika Street, from the intersection of Opelika Street and East Main Street or Rock Mills Road along Opelika street in a southerly direction to the City Limits; and on North Main or Wedowee Street from the end of the present brick paving to the City Limits on the north.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, that the grade of East Main or Rock Mills Road, from the end of the present brick paving to a point 2100 feet east to Anglin Street; and Opelika Street; from the intersection of Opelika street and East Main street or Rock Mills Road along Opelika Street in a southerly direction to the City Limits; and on North Main or Wedowee Street from the end of present brick paving to the City Limits on the North and the curbs on both sides thereof be and the same are hereby fixed and established as shown on profile sheets Nos.1,2,3,4 and 5, heretofore exhibited to this City Council and now on file in the office of the City Clerk.
