

ORDINANCE NO. 264

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, as follows:

Section 1: Any person who throws, sweeps or in any manner deposits any loose garbage, rubbish, refuse, trash, leaves, glass or sticks into or onto any sidewalk or street or public alley shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction therefor shall be fined not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) and not more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00). PROVIDED, however, the provisions of this ordinance shall not prohibit the throwing, sweeping or depositing of garbage, rubbish, refuse, trash, leaves, glass or sticks into substantial garbage cans, substantial boxes or other substantial receptacles placed upon any street or sidewalk or public alley, for collection and disposal by the City.
