AN ORDINANCE

NO. 475

ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE MAYOR'S AND COUNCILMEN'S SALARY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, as follows:

Section 1. That the salary of the Mayor of the City of Roanoke, shall be and the same is hereby fixed that the sum of \$208.34 per month.

Section 2. That each councilman shall be paid at the rate of \$20.00 per month as compensation in connection with his duties as member of the council.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective on the first Monday in October, 1964, and shall continue in force

AN ORDINANCE
NO. 476

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Title 37, Section 404, Code of Alabama 1940, as amended the City Council of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, shall consist of a mayor and five aldermen who shall be elected from the City of Roanoke at large by the qualified electors of the City of Roanoke at general municipal elections to be held on the second Tuesday in August, 1964, and quandrennially thereafter.
