



AN ORDINANCE

NO. 501

ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE MAYOR'S AND COUNCILMEN'S SALARY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the salary of the mayor of the City of Roanoke shall be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of \$ 208.34 per month.

SECTION 2. That each councilman shall be paid at the rate of \$ 20.00 per month as compensation in connection with his duties as member of the council.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective on the

first Monday in October, 1968, and shall continue in force and effect until repealed by action of the council.

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION REQUESTING CERTAIN MUNICIPAL IAD FUNDS FOR NEEDED STREET IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Roanoke, Alabama has certain tax funds accrued to their credit under Act 224, Special Session, 1967 Legislature; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined by this body that certain street and road improvements are necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roanoke, Alabama desires to use \$38,600.00 for construction of projects including \$(None) City/County engineering and \$1,930.00 (5%) for State Administrative Cost as outlined in Municipal Aid Regulations dated 10/1/67.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOVED by the Governing Body of the City of Roanoke, Alabama as follows:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to pledge the City of Roanoke, Alabama accruals covering project cost as shown above and 5% for State Administrative Cost as shown above on State Highway Department's Form MA 1-67 dated _____.
