

Ordinance shall upon conviction be subject to a fine of not less than One Dollar and not more than One Hundred Dollars, and any such Establishment wherein such violation occurs shall be liable to have its license revoked.

3. This Ordinance shall be of force and effect upon the publication thereof.

ORDINANCE

No. 436

To further provide for the Public Convenience and Welfare of the Citizens and the City of Roanoke, Alabama, and to require that all places and structures used for residence, business, commercial or industrial use, and all other structures customarily given structure number and being related to the Street Block Numbering System shall be renumbered:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA as follows:

AM217



A. That all structures and places used for residence, business commercial or industrial use, and all other structures and buildings customarily given structure or building numbers and being related to Street Block Numbering, be and the same are to be re-numbered for the Public Convenience, Welfare and the use of the Citizens of the City of Roanoke, Alabama.

B. Further provided that all Citizens and property owners in said City shall aid and assist those in charge of such re-numbering when called upon as to entry upon said premises, as to knowledge and information to said premises, and that user, or occupant or owner of said premises shall be given a mimeographed copy of instructions as to how to affix and otherwise in placing said numbers, when re-numbered;

C. And further provided that such Numbers shall be placed in a conspicuous place where the same may be easily readable by the General Public from the street or in passing in front of said building or structure;

D. And further provided that such re-numbering shall be had and completed on or before 90 days after the enactment and publication of this Ordinance;

E. And further provided that the Mayor is authorized and empowered to make and enter into contracts for the carrying out of the renumbering as is provided and contained in this Ordinance.
