## ORDINANCE NO. 567

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF WILD, STRAY OR ABONDONED DOGS.

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as any dog found running at large upon the streets of the City of Roanoke, Alabama. or on public property or private property owned or occupied by any person, firm or corporation not the owner of said dog, without an identification collar or rabies tag, and which dog appears to be diseased and undernourished, or rabid, and as to which any law enforcement officer of the City of Roanoke, Alabama has probable cause to believe has no known fixed place of abode at any household in the City of Roanoke, Alabama:

Section 3. Any wild, stray or abandoned dog may be impounded in accordance with law or ordinances now or hereafter adopted, in accordance therewith.

Section4. Any wild, stray or abandoned dog whose actions constitute a danger of immediate personal injury to any person may be killed by any law enforcement officer of the City of Roanoke, Alabama.

Section 5. Every police officer or other law enforcemnet officer of the City of Roanoke, Alabama is authorized to enforce this ordinance. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to

authorize any private person to enforce this ordinance or to do any act in violation of any law.

Section 6. The provisions of this ordinance are severable.

If any part of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutuional, such declaration shall not affect the part which remains.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon its passage and adoption as provided by law.

## ORDINANCE NO. 568

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, AND THE ZONING MAP OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA TO REZONE OR RECLASSIFY CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA FROM RESIDENCE "A" DISTRICT, RESIDENCE "B" DISTRICT AND RESIDENCE 'C" DISTRICT TO GENERAL BUSINESS DISTRICT, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, and the Aoning Map of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, be amended, altered and changed to rezone and reclassify in the manner hereinafter provided the following described property located in the City of Roanoke, Randolph County, Alabama, to-wit;

All land lying and being along and on either side of the right-of-way of U.S. Highway 431, known as The Roanoke By-Pass, and extending back from each right-of-way line a distance of four hundred (400) feet in each direction, and being further described as strips
