

ORDINANCE #271

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That schedule or subdivision numbered 46 of Section 1 of the License Code of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, adopted by Ordinance No. 256, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

46-(a) CONCERTS-Each person, firm or corporation conducting or presenting a musical entertainment, public lecture, play or other like entertainment for which admission is charged, unless given wholly to charitable, religious, civic or school purposes, per day, only-\$20.00.


(b) PUBLIC DANCE-Each person, association of persons, club, society, firm or corporation conducting or sponsoring or presenting a public dance<sup>or</sup> conducting or operating a public dance hall, whether or not a ~~an~~ charge is made for dancing, per day only - \$10.00.
