CITY TAX ORDINANCE NO.598 TO LEVY TAXES FOR THE CITY TAX YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 1982.

Section 1: That taxes are hereby levied for the City of Roanoke, Alabama, on all real and personal property and other properties and franchishes located or taxable in the City of Roanoke, Alabama, for the year 1982, based upon the valuation as assessed for state taxation during last year as follows: 1. A tax of one-half of one percentum, or fifty cents on each One Hundred Dollars valuation to be applied exclusively to the payment of bonds heretofore issued and the interest thereon.
2. A tax of one-half of one per centum, or fifty cents on each One Hundred Dollars valuation for general municipal purposes.
3. A tax of one-half of one percentum, or fifty cents on each One Hundred Dollars valuation for school purposes, School District No. 2, Randolph County, Alabama.
