

GRADE ORDINANCE NO. 299


An Ordinance fixing and establishing the grade of Peachtree and Trammell Streets, from the intersection of Peachtree street with the pavement on Main Street, thence going in an Easterly direction along Peachtree Street 1,113 feet to the intersection of Trammell Street, thence up Trammell Street in a Southerly direction 226 feet to the end of the pavement on Trammell Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, As FOLLOWS:

That the Grade of Peachtree and Trammell Streets, and that the curbs on both sides thereof from the intersection of Peachtree street with the pavement on Main Street, thence going in an Easterly direction along Peachtree Street 1,113 feet to the intersection of Trammell Street, thence up Trammell Street in a South-diræction 226 feet to the end of the pavement on Trammell Street, and the same is hereby fixed as shown on Profile Sheet S-4 and heretofore exhibited to the City Council and now on file in the City Council Chamber.
