GRADE ORDINANCE NO. 317

An Ordinance to fix and establish the grade on Rock Mills Street in the City of Roanoke, Alabama, towit: That part of Rock Mills Street or 1,000 feet of Rock Mills Street and being that part of Rock Mills Street that runs from the Eastern City Limits line in a West-erly direction to the pavement on Rock Mills Street, or where Rock Mills Street becomes a part of High-way No. 37.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, as Follows:

That the grade of Rock Mills Street or 1,000 feet thereof, or that part of the same that runs from the Eastern City Limits line in a Western direction to the pavement on Rock Mills Street or where Rock Mills Street becomes a part of Highway No. 37, with the curbs on both sides thereof, be and the same is hereby fixed as shown on Profile Sheet AYZ and heretofore exhibited to the City Council and now on file in the City Council Chamber.
