

Resolution 659B

Whereas, the City of Roanoke proposes to construct or have constructed recreational resources at the Roanoke Sports Complex to provide for the health and well being of the general public, and

Whereas, the City of Roanoke intends to make application to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs for grant assistance from the Land and Water Conservation Fund or Alabama Recreation Capital Development Assistance Fund, and

Whereas, said programs are limited to funding a maximum of fifty percent (50%) of the proposed project costs (not to exceed \$30,000.00) estimated at \$Twenty-two thousand two hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$22,275.00) which will be used to construct facilities consisting of the a basketball court and a pavilion and installing picnic tables at the Roanoke Sports Complex.

Now therefore be it resolved, that the City of Roanoke hold in reserve fifty percent (50%) of the proposed project cost for the purpose of matching the Land and Water Conservation Fund assistance, and

Be it further resolved, that in the event a grant is awarded, the City of Roanoke understands that it will sign assurances to comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, rules and regulations.
