
ORDINANCE #254

TO LEVY TAXES FOR THE CITY TAX YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1st, 1933.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, as follows:

SECTION 1: That taxes are hereby levied for the City of Roanoke, Alabama, on all real and personal property and other properties and franchises located or taxable in the City of Roanoke, Alabama, for the year 1933, based upon the valuation of such real and personal property and other properties and franchises as assessed for state taxation during last year, as follows:

(1) A Tax of one-half of per centum, or fifty cents on each one hundred dollars of valuation, for general municipal purposes.

(2) A further tax of one-half of one per centum, or fifty cents on each one hundred dollars valuation, to be applied exclusively to the payment of bonds heretofore issued and the interest thereon.
