ORDINANCE NO. 644

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE QUALIFICATION FEES FOR MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR CANDIDATES SEEKING OFFICE AS MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: A qualification fee in the amount of \$50.00 is hereby fixed and imposed upon all candidates seeking election as Mayor of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, except as hereinafter provided for.

SECTION II: A qualification fee in the amount of \$25.00 is hereby fixed and imposed upon all candidates seeking election as Councilmember of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, except as hereinafter provided for.

SECTION III: Such qualification fee shall be paid to the City Clerk and deposited to the general fund of the City at or prior to the time of taking out qualification papers by any such candidates.

SECTION IV: Any person desiring to qualify, who is not financially able to pay the required fee, may qualify provied such prospective candidate furnishes the Clerk with an affidavit stating that he is financially unable to pay the required fee fixed by this Ordinance.

SECTION V: This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to Section 11-6-2 of the Alabama Code of 1975 and shall be effective in all elections, both general and special, for aforesaid offices from and after the date of adoption.
