ORDINANCE NO.272

TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF PICTURE SHOWS ON SUNDAY IN THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, AND THE POLICE JURISDICTION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to conduct or operate a Picture Show in the City of Roanoke, Alabama, or in the Police Jurisdiction thereof, on a Sunday.

SECTION 2: Any person, firm or corporation who conducts or operates a Picture Show in the City of Roanoke, Alabama, or in the Police Juris-diction thereof on a Sunday, shall be a violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: Any person, firm, or corporation who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of violating the same, and shall be subject to a fine of One Cent to One Hundred Dollars.
