
AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH POLLING HOURS

ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1: Pursuant to Section 11-46-28, Code of Alabama

6:00 o'clock p.m.


SECTION II: This ordinance shall become effective immediately




