

PERMIT -- ORDINANCE

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1: No person or persons shall erect or cause to be erected within the limits of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, any building or addition to a building, or build or cause to be built within the City limits of Roanoke any sidewalk, or any part of a sidewalk, or change or cause to be changed the location of any sidewalk, or part thereof, without first having obtained a written permit from the Mayor of the City of Roanoke, giving the location of the sidewalk or building, or part thereof, to be built.

SECTION 2: Any person violating any provision contained in this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$1.00 and not more than \$100.00.

SECTION 3: Any person who causes, permits or suffers any work to be done in violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, in addition to the punishment provided for in Section 2, for each day that such work is maintained in such violation, be fined not less than \$1.00 and not more than \$100.00.

AN ORDINANCE TO LEAVY CITY TAX

To Levy Taxes for the City Tax Year commencing October 1st., 1927.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Roanoke, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Taxes are hereby levied for the City Tax Year Commencing on the 1st day of October, 1927, on all real and personal property and other properties and franchises in the City of Roanoke, subject to taxation by the laws of the State of Alabama, based on said valuation as shown by the books of assessment for the State and County for the Tax Year ending on the 30th day of September, 1927, as follows:

- (1). A tax of one half of one percentum or fifty cents on the One Hundred Dollars' valuation for general municipal purposes.
- (2). A further tax of one half of one percentum or fifty cents on the One Hundred Dollars' valuation to be applied exclusively to the payment of bonds heretofore issued and the interest thereon.
