## ORDINANCE # 657

ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A TRAILER COURT ON PROPERTY CURRENTLY ZONED AS CLASS C RESIDENTIAL:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA, that a zoning amendment be made to establish a trailer court on property currently zoned a class C residential pursuant to Article 6 of the 1951 Zoning Ordinance of the City of Roanoke, as ammended in accordance with zoning Ordinance 494 Section 4(A) of the Ordinances of the City of Roanoke, regarding property located in the City of Roanoke, Randolph County, Alabama, to wit:

Randolph County, Alabama Township 21-5, Range 12 E. shown on plat dated

December 29, 1954, made by Clarence J. White, Jr., a professional engineer and
surveyor, recorded in Plat Book No. 1, Page 4, in the office of the Judge of Probate

Randolph County, Alabama, referred to as being Parcel 1, Tract "G" and being parts

of Blocks 2 and 5, being more particularly described as the unplatted portion of
said blocks lying East of lots 2, 3, and 4 in said block 5 and East of lot 3 in said
block 2 being bounded on the South by Piedmont Street, and on the North by North

line of the S.E. ½ of S.W. ½, Section 26; said parcel contains 3.8951 acres.
