## **ORDINANCE 2022-04-04**

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA TO EXEMPT CERTAIN COVERED ITEMS FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX DURING THE THIRD WEEKEND OF JULY 2022, JULY 15-17, AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT 2006-574, GENERALLY KNOWN AS THE STATE SALES TAX HOIDAY LEGISLATION."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** In conformity with the provisions of Act 2006-574 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2006 Regular Session, providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday. The City of Roanoke, Alabama exempts "covered items" from the municipal sales and use tax during the same period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday July 15, 2022, and ending at 11:59 p.m. (midnight) on Sunday July 17, 2022.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2006-574, except that the time period shall be only specified in Section 1 above and not all years thereafter.

**Section 3.** The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance under the seal of the City of Roanoke, Alabama and forward said copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue and Avenu Insights & Analytics, (formerly Revenue Discovery Systems, RDS), to be recorded and posted on both departments website.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
